

# **Parental Bill of Rights Policy**

Legal Reference: 70 O.S. § 11-105.1

### **Purpose**

Proud To Partner Leadership Academy (PTPLA) respects and upholds the rights of parents and guardians to direct the upbringing, education, and care of their children, as provided under Oklahoma law.

### **Policy Details**

- 1. Parental Rights Recognized: Parents and guardians have the right to:
  - Access and review all instructional materials used in the education of their child.
  - Receive advance written notice of any instruction related to:
    - Human sexuality
    - Sexual orientation
    - Gender identity
    - Any related sensitive topics

#### 2. Opt-Out Rights:

- Parents have the right to opt their child out of instruction addressing human sexuality issues.
- A written opt-out form will be provided at least two (2) weeks before the scheduled instruction.

#### 3. Review of Materials:

 All instructional materials, including teacher manuals, films, tapes, and other supplementary materials, will be available for inspection by parents/guardians



upon request.

## 4. Notification Requirements:

- o PTPLA will provide advance written notice regarding:
  - The nature of the content
  - Dates of instruction
  - Access instructions for review of materials

### 5. Complaint Procedure:

- Parents may file a complaint with the Administrative Assistant if they believe their rights under this policy have been violated.
- Complaints will be addressed promptly and according to school grievance procedures.
